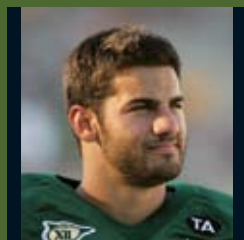


# What a Kick!

Two National Awards  
for Daniel Sepulveda

Daniel Sepulveda, son of Interstate Batteries' President & CEO Carlos Sepulveda and his wife Susan, has been making news with his college football accomplishments in recent months. Daniel was named the nation's best punter in college football when he became the first two-time winner of the Ray Guy Award. (Guy is considered the best punter in the history of the NFL.) Daniel earned this honor as a sophomore in 2004 and as a senior in 2006. In addition, Daniel was named first-team All-America by the Walter Camp Football Foundation, widely considered the most prestigious All-America team. Beyond that, Daniel is the only unanimous All-American football player who is also first-team Academic All-American.

His dad Carlos, who began coaching Daniel in football when he was in fourth grade, said, **"Knowing that Daniel tore his ACL last April and seeing how hard he worked to recover in such a short time makes these awards even more meaningful."**

Daniel now holds two all-time NCAA career records! His career punting average (45.24 yards per punt) is the best in the history of Division I football for players with at least 50 punts. He also established an NCAA record with 94 career punts of 50-plus yards.
